



## Eliminator

*Eliminator* is a challenging, fun event that generates a real buzz of positive energy and sense of collective achievement.

Your teams are set a challenge and a deadline. 100 gold nuggets will purchase a rusty key to open a treasure box - but only if gold nuggets are accumulated before the deadline is reached!

Participants, each receive a sealed envelope containing a special *Team Challenge Mission Sheet*. This sheet outlines a challenging team task that, through successful completion, offers the opportunity to win lots of shiny gold nuggets!

Team members have 15 minutes to assimilate the key points about their mission - Mission Control is on hand to answer questions and offer advice. At the end of this time each team member presents his/her *Team Challenge* to the rest of the team.

There is insufficient time and resources for all *Team Challenges* to be completed. Decisions need to be made about which challenges to select and which to eliminate. There are many options available...for example, the team may decide to send 5 team members on the *Badlands Challenge*, while the remainders tackle the *Card Sharp Challenge*. On returning to *Mission Control*, the whole team may reform to take on the *Marble Run Challenge*.

*Eliminator* is a very versatile event. We have a wide range of *Team Challenges* for you to choose from. *Team Challenges* need to offer the right level of challenge (both cerebral and physical), and to ensure there is something for everyone. If the weather looks like being poor we can, if you wish, switch to indoor challenges - this event is a great success in fair weather or foul!
