



## Wacky Races!

Wacky Races is a fun and active team building event inspired by the popular TV series of the same name. The plot is simple...outlandish teams compete in a series of races around the globe in their magnificent racing machines to become "The World's Wackiest Racer".

Each team creates suitable team identity (remember *Penelope Pitstop*, the *Arkansas Chugabug*, *The Ant Hill Mob* etc.) and a basic kart chassis on which to create their dream machine. Additional construction equipment will be sold by competitive auction or by completing racing-related challenges.

Our karts are made from wood (not cardboard) but require no technical skills to assemble – just teamwork. Your kart comes with a proper steering rack as standard to allow for maximum fun when the races kick-off. Each team customises their kart to create a colourful and eye-catching vehicle to carry team members in the races. A parade of competitors will take place before the race series begins. A test race (perhaps involving a slalom, relay race or pit-stop) will determine starting positions on the grid for the Grand Prix finale showdown! Teams jockey for position around the karts, the starter is poised before karts are launched down the track and the finale race is on! The checkered flag signals the winning kart and the end of the race to great applause.

With scores totaled, the results are announced and Champagne presented to the triumphant team. This is a good time to make yourself scarce if you want to avoid the traditional Champagne soaking. We provide a Race Co-ordinator, marshals, bunting and race course, covered area (gazebos) for Race Control, checkered flag, podium, megaphone, trophy and all the equipment, and tools for the karts.

Wacky Races is a great team building event to pep-up your meeting or awayday.
